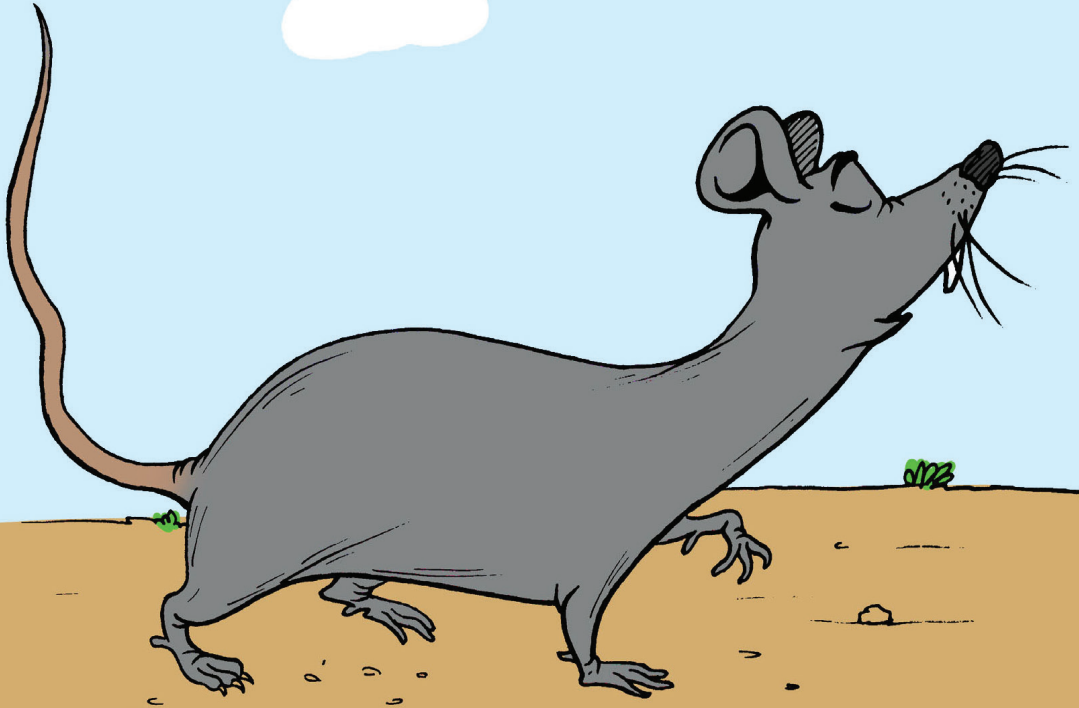
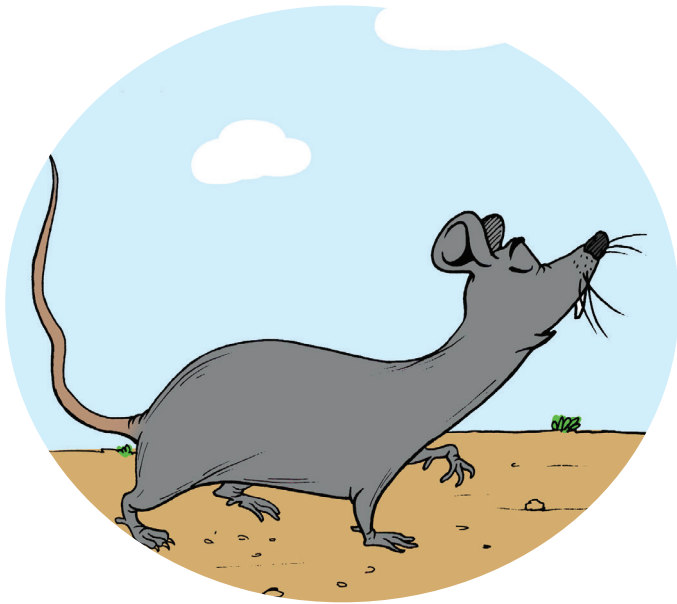

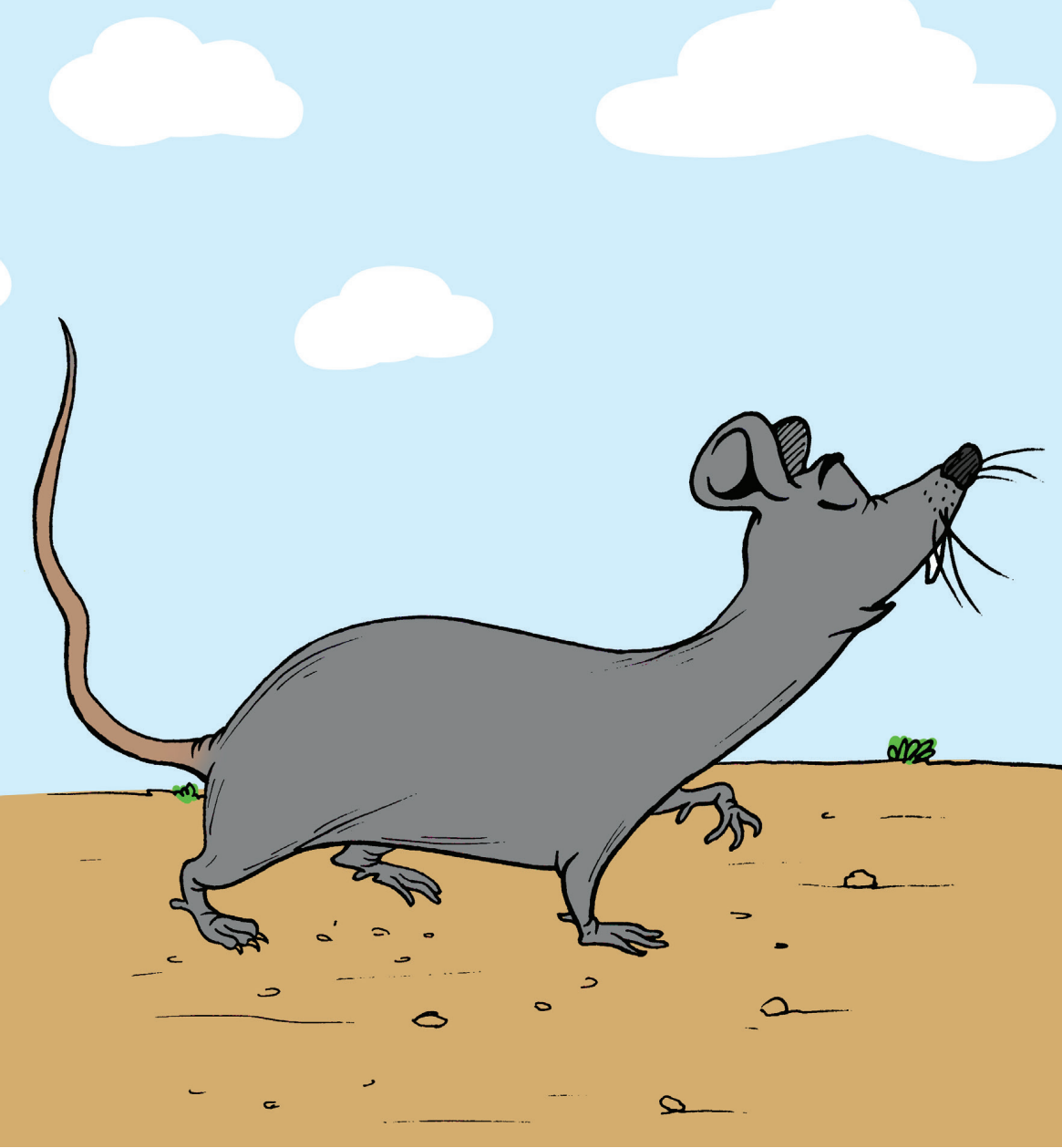

It was grey.



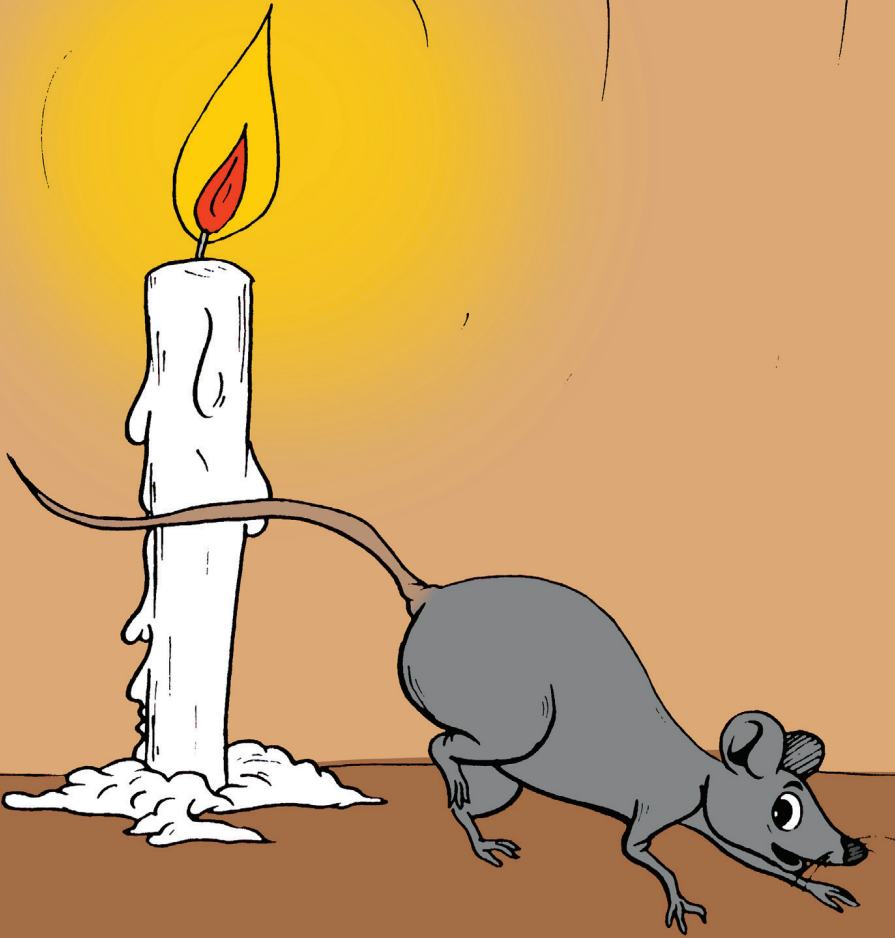
It had a long neck.



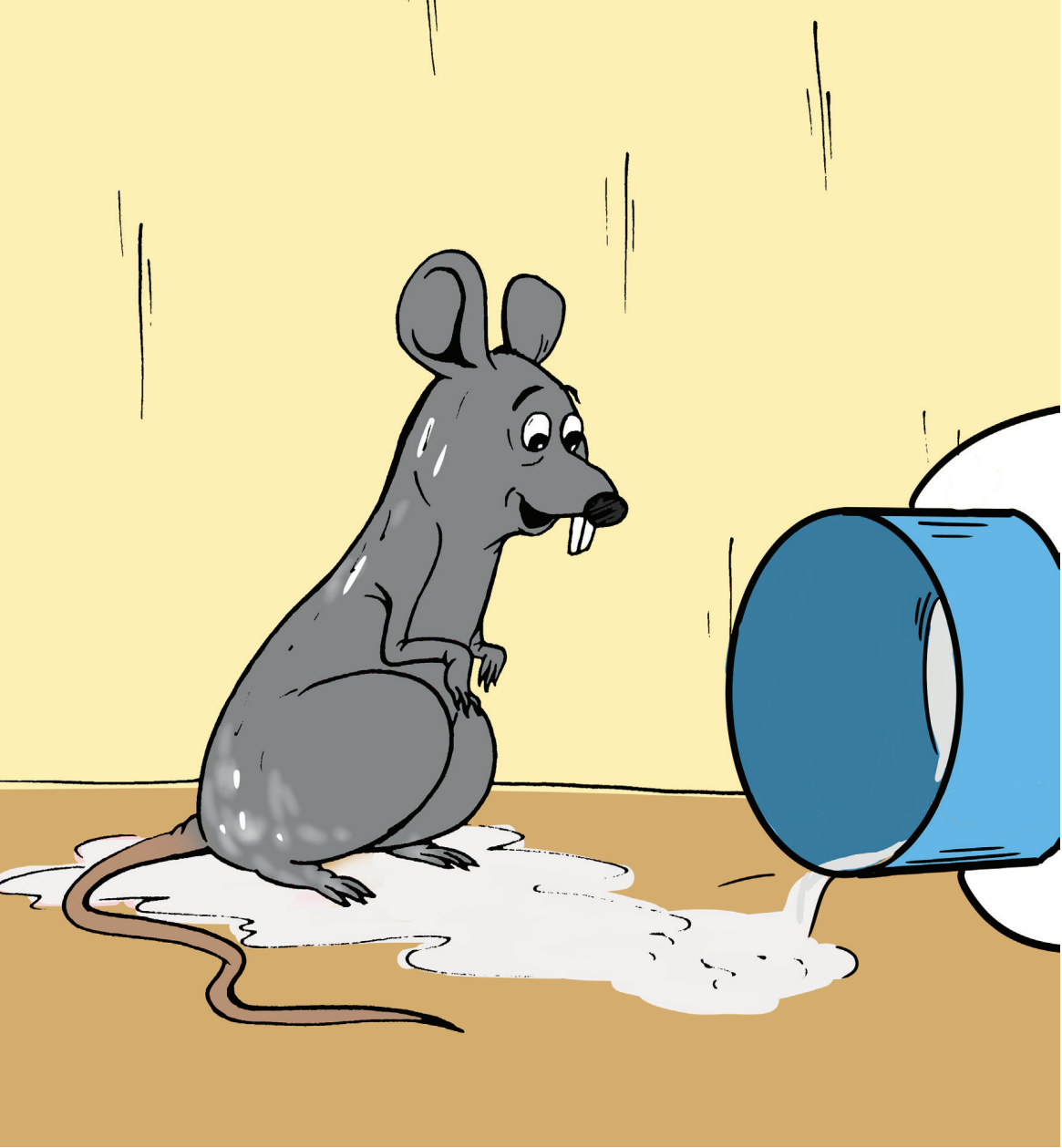
It was stubborn, it rummaged everywhere.



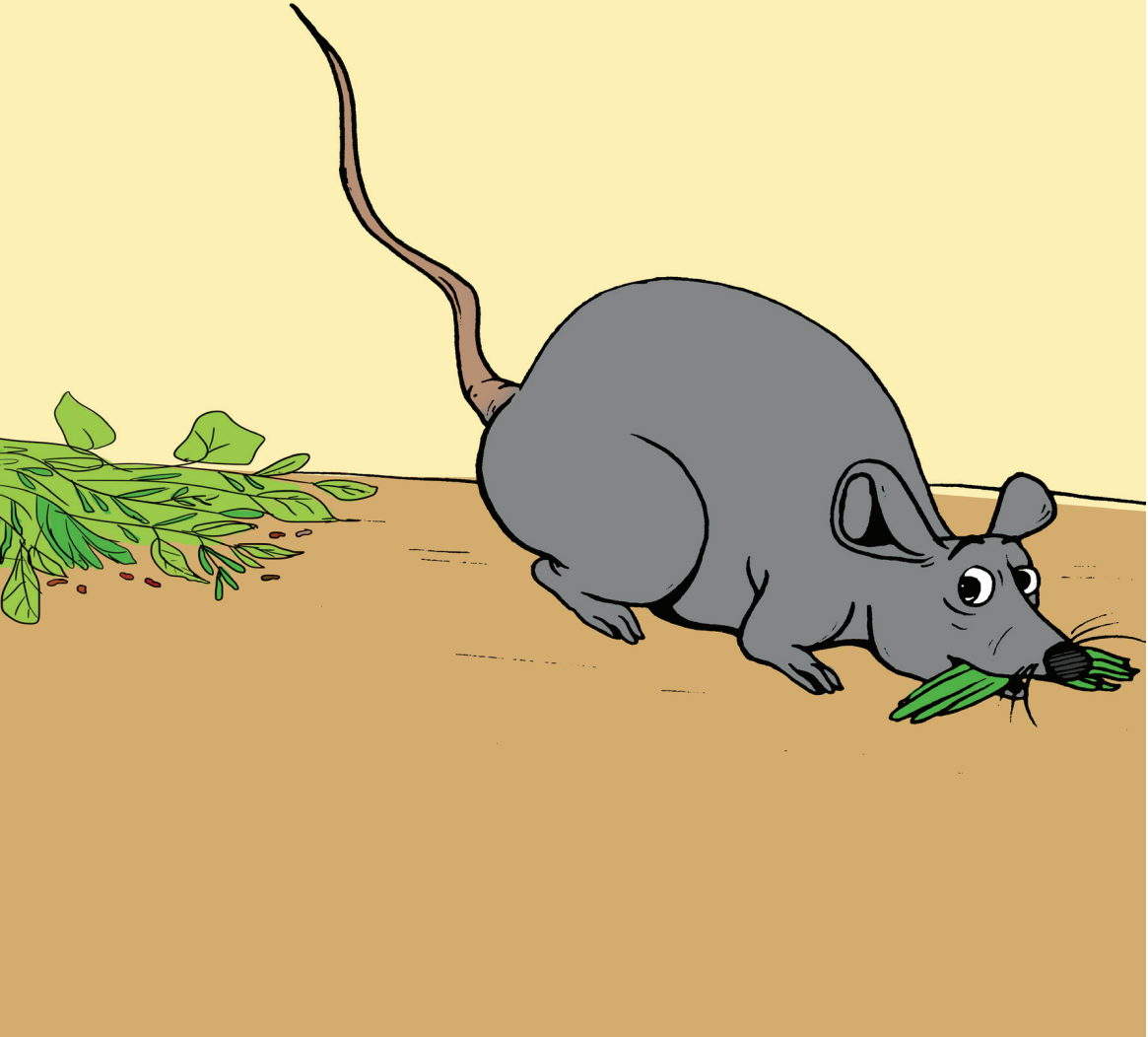
It squeaked from up there.



It was silly. It fell on a burning candle.



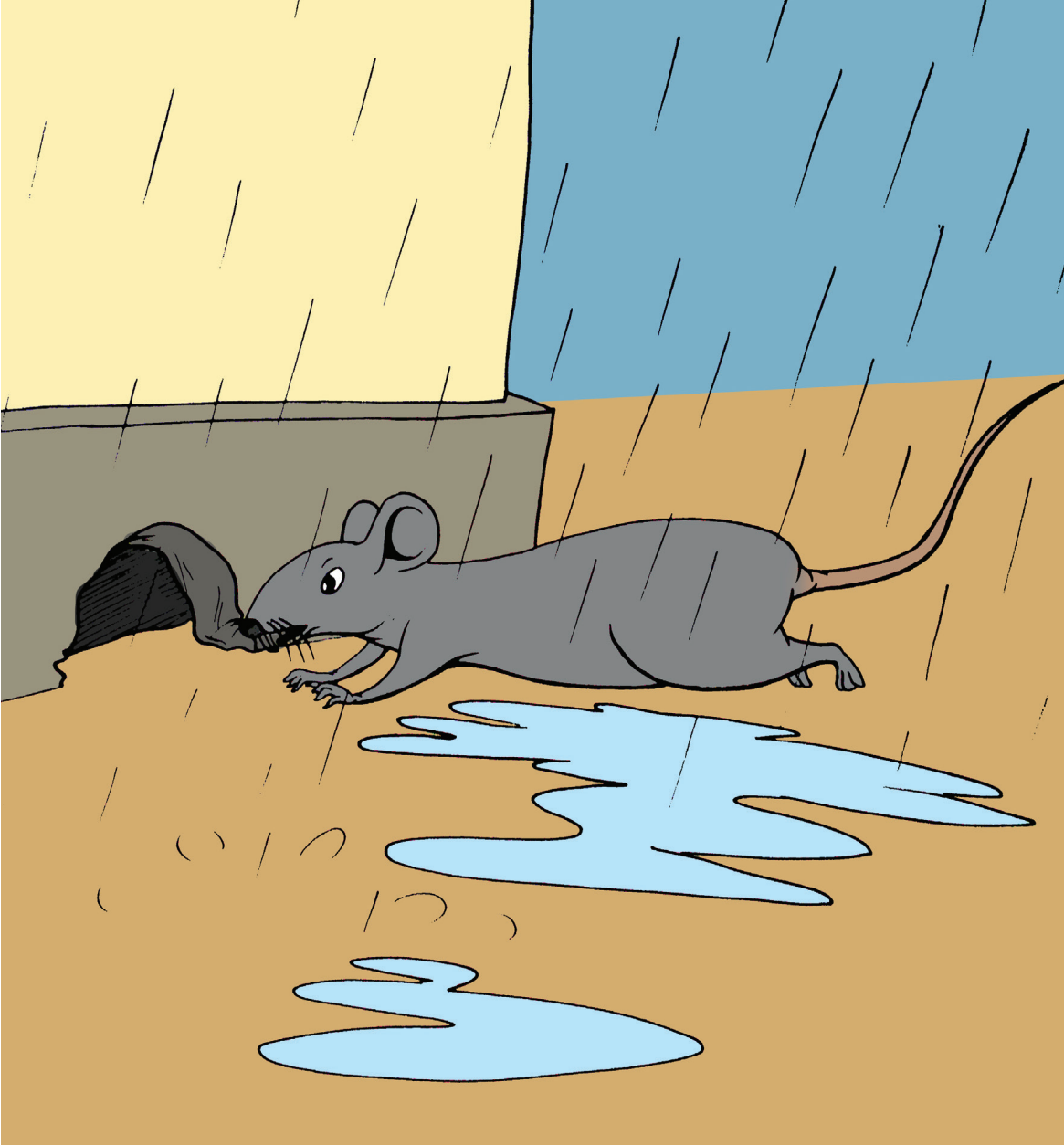
Yesterday, it came here dripping in oil.
