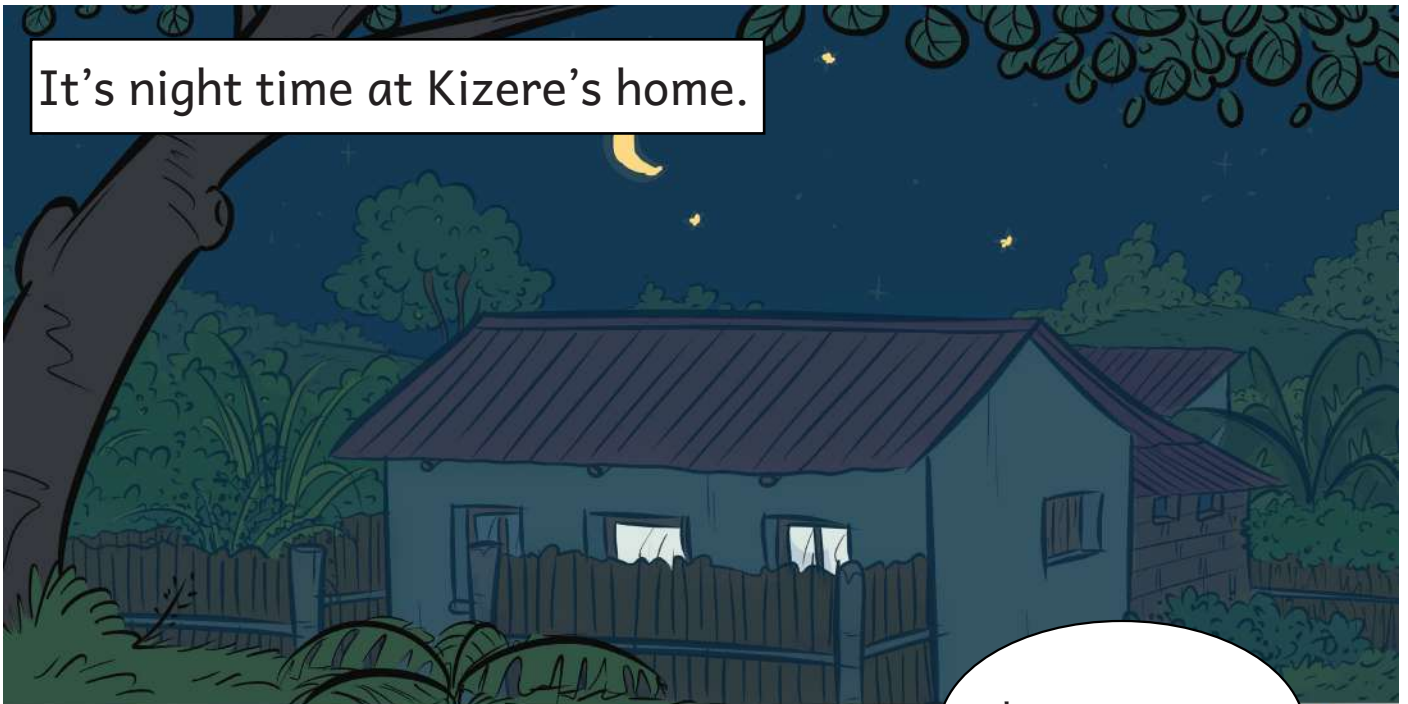

restroom.

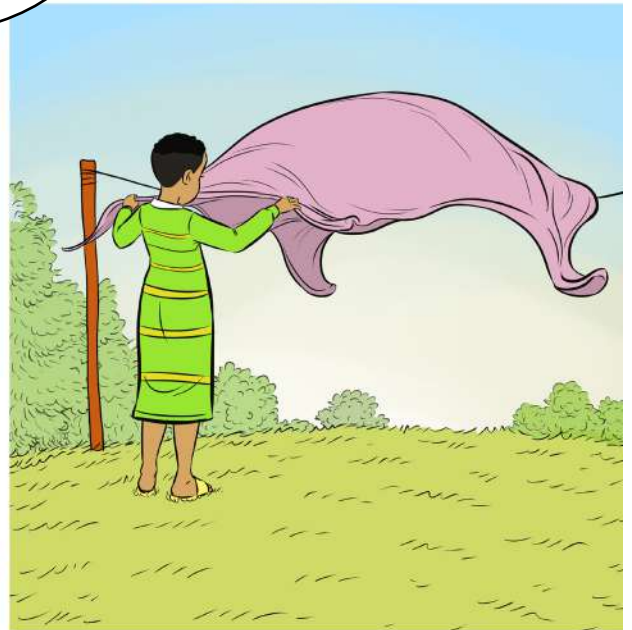
Ahiii! I was

Kizere left to dry the sheets.

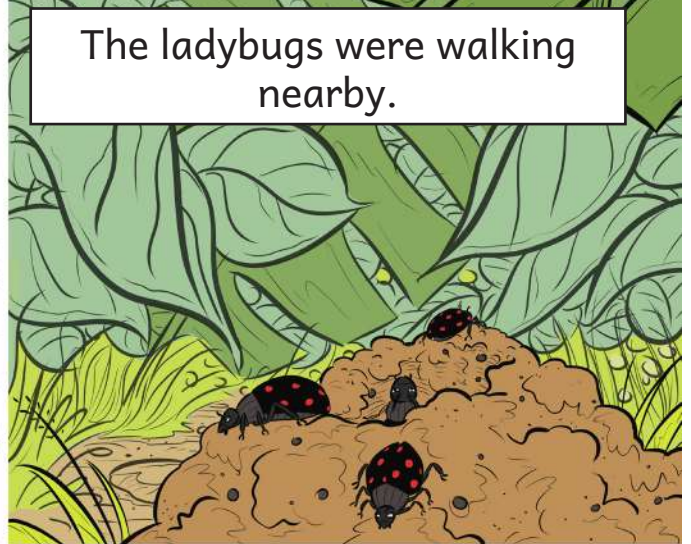
Off

sheets.



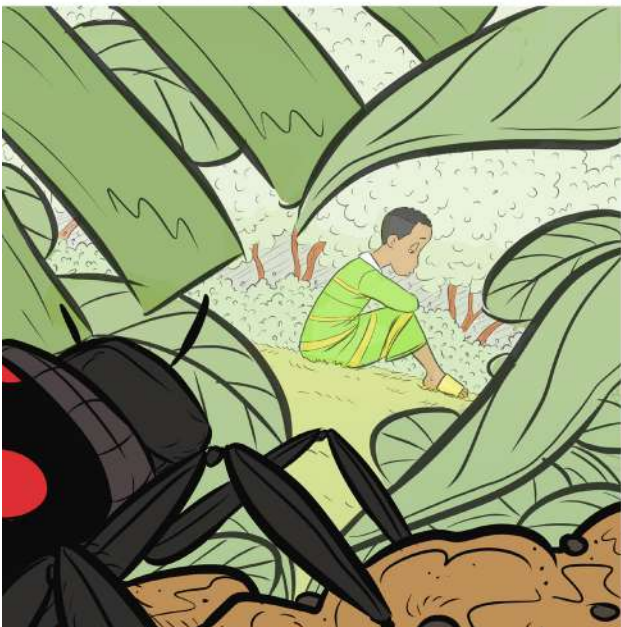
Oh

After pulling up the sheets, Kizere sat down in the garden.



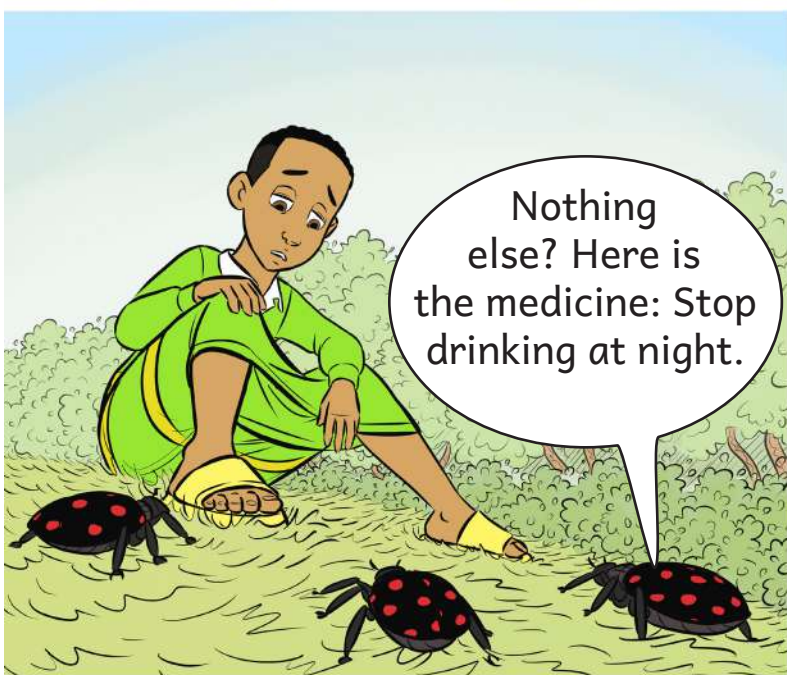
The ladybugs were walking nearby.

I have a big problem with wetting the bed! And I have no solution.



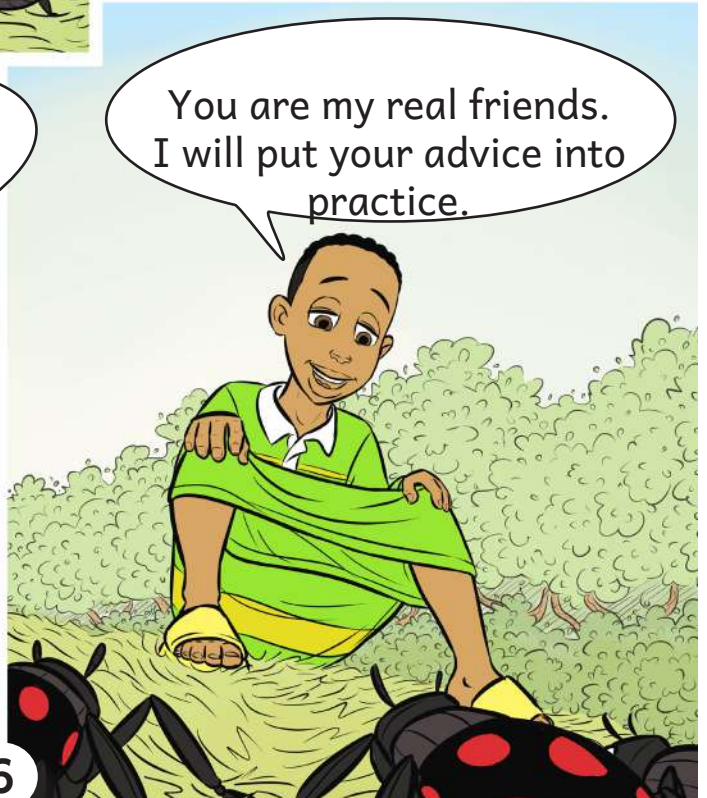
Nothing else? Here is the medicine: Stop drinking at night.

She should drink the water drops that are on the colocase leaf.

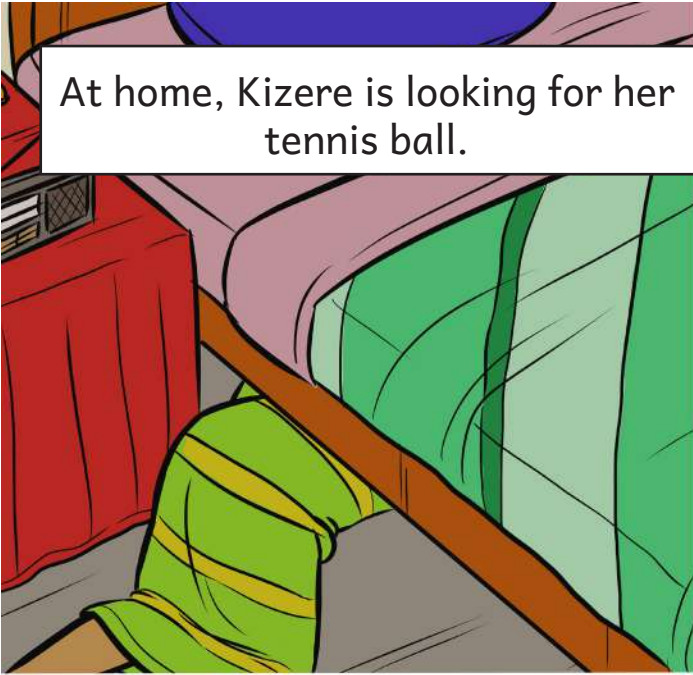


Yes! Yes! Drink the water found on the colocase leaf.

Kizere! Kizere!



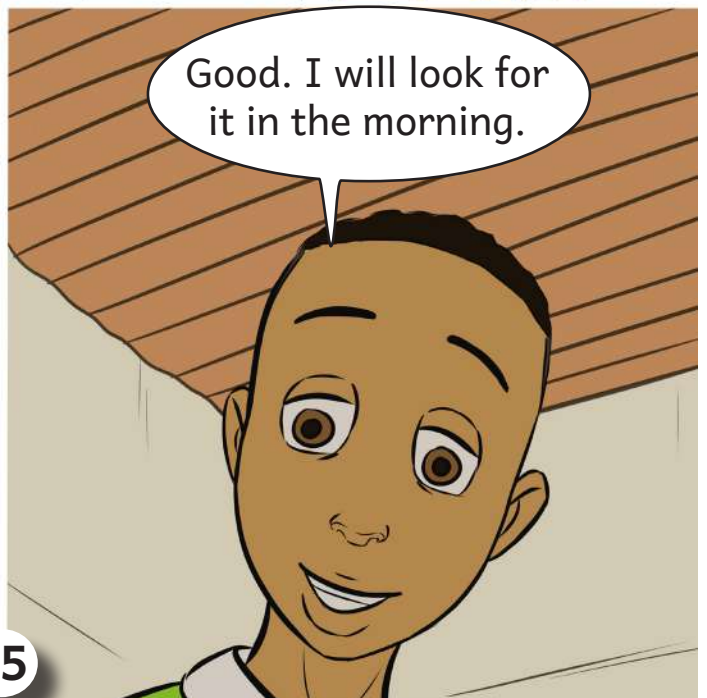
I am up here.

Kizere slept worried.



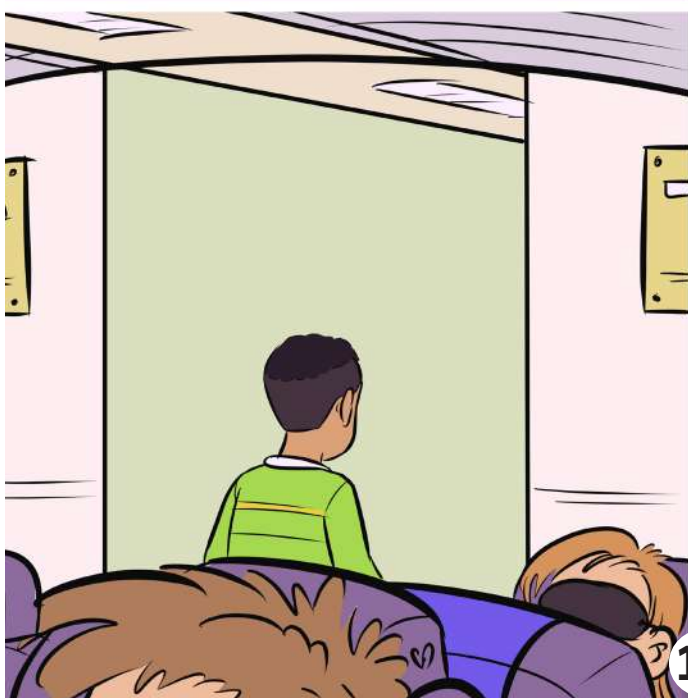
Zzzzzzzzzzz

Good afternoon.

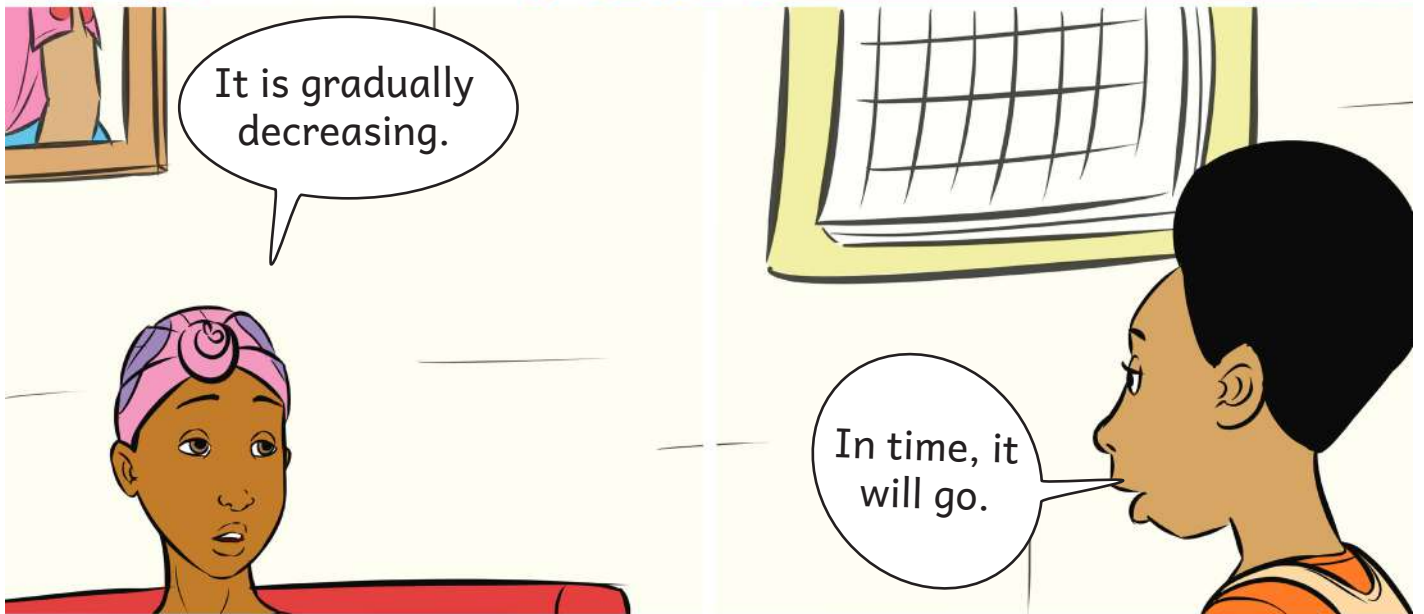
You came with

Kizere, you know that we love you.

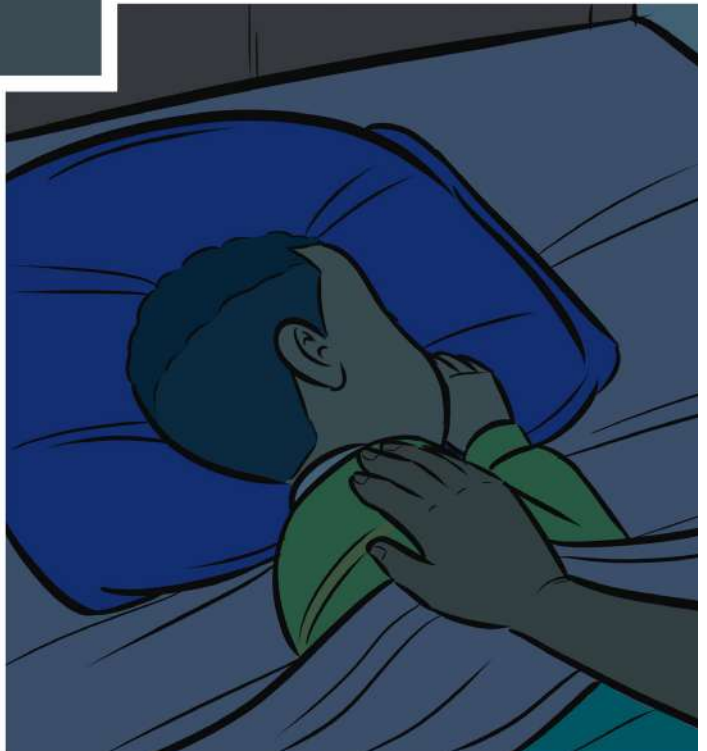
We will help you wake up during the night, to go to the restroom. This will solve your problem with wetting the bed.

During the night, Kizere is in bed.

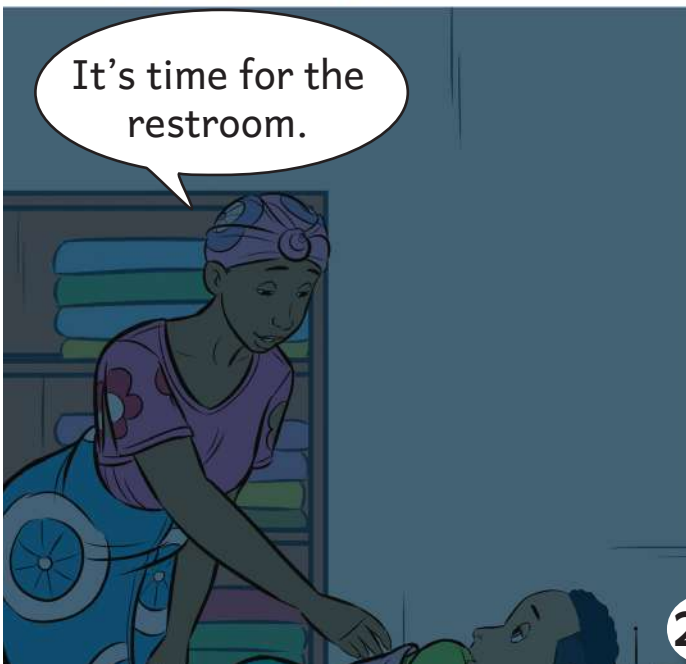


Her mother comes to wake her up.
