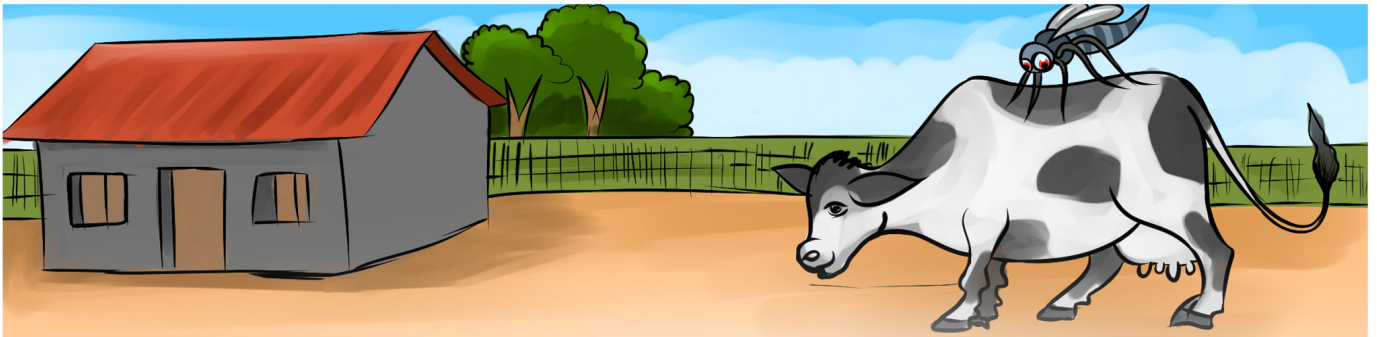
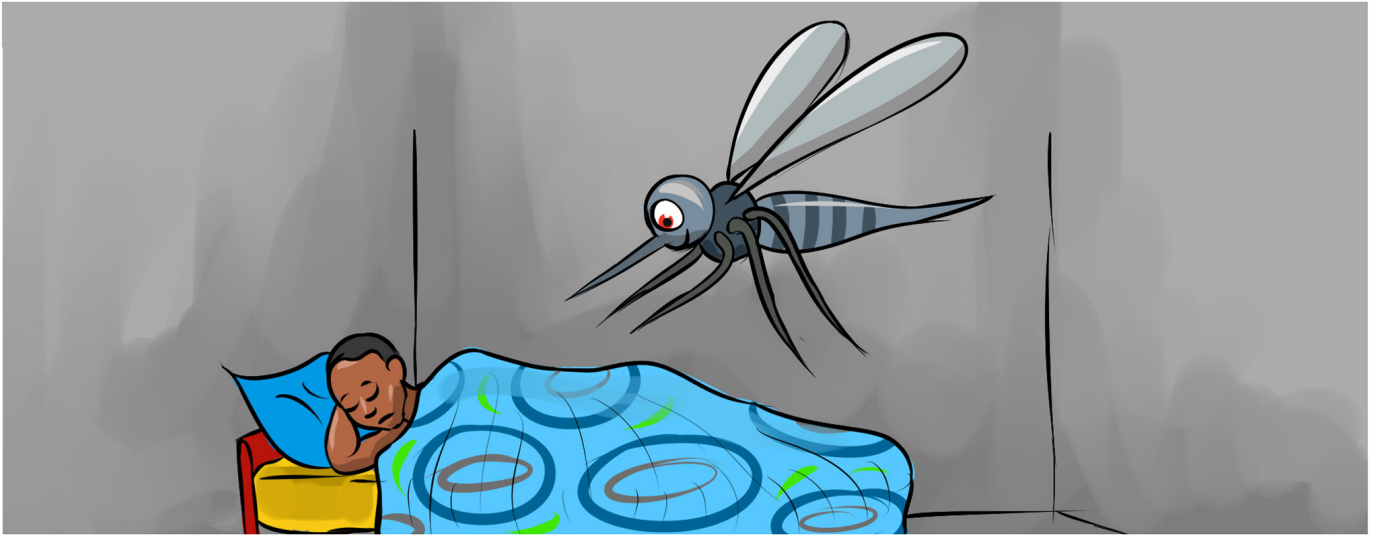
Mr. Mosquito and Mr. Bee lived together in the bamboo forest. One day, there was a King called Mr. Butterfly who loved them very much.



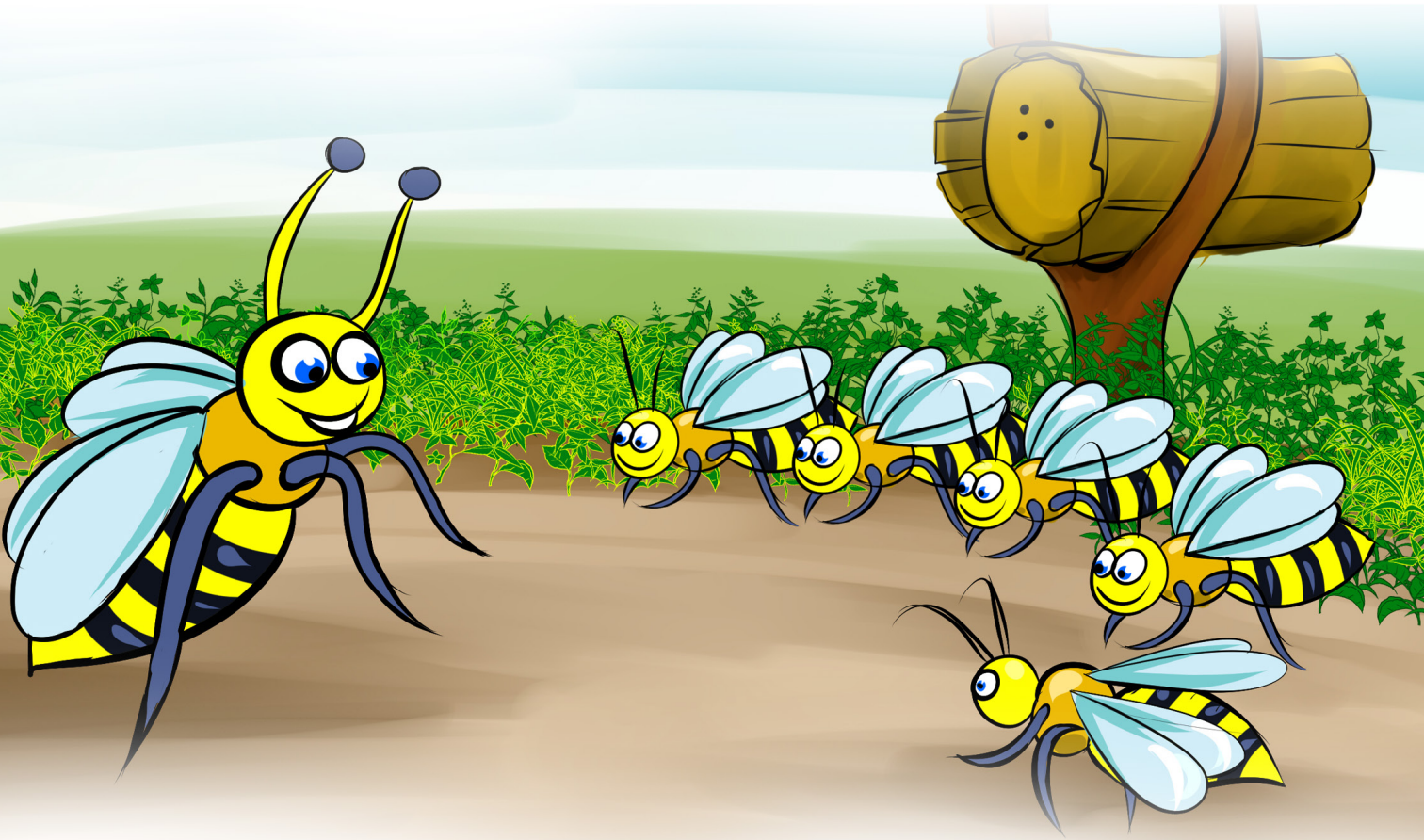

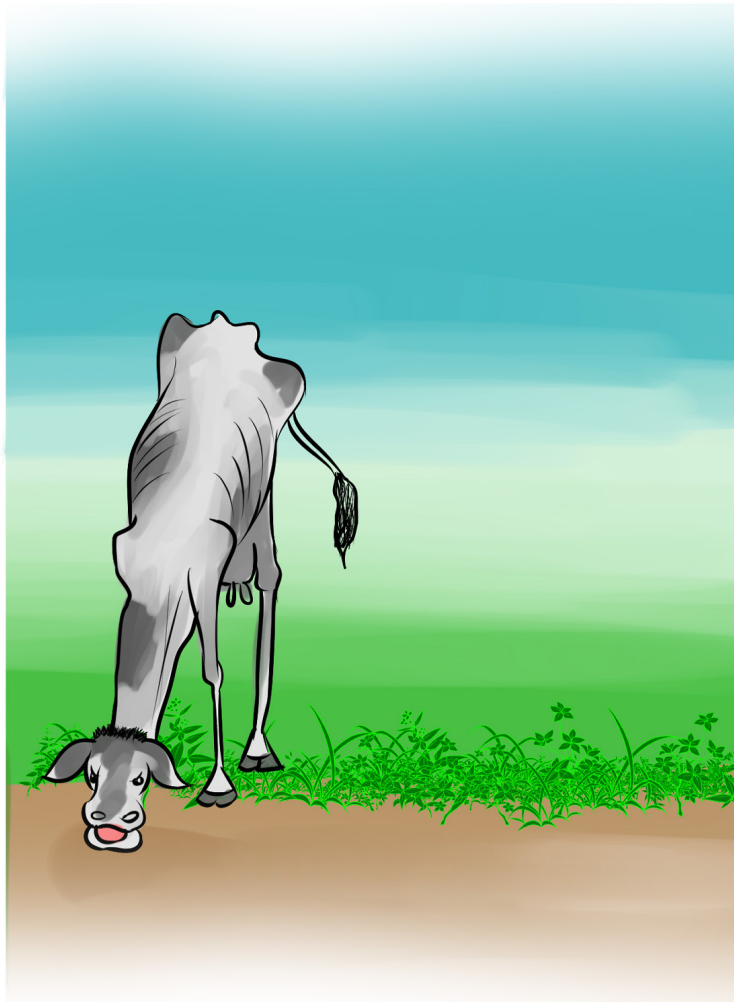
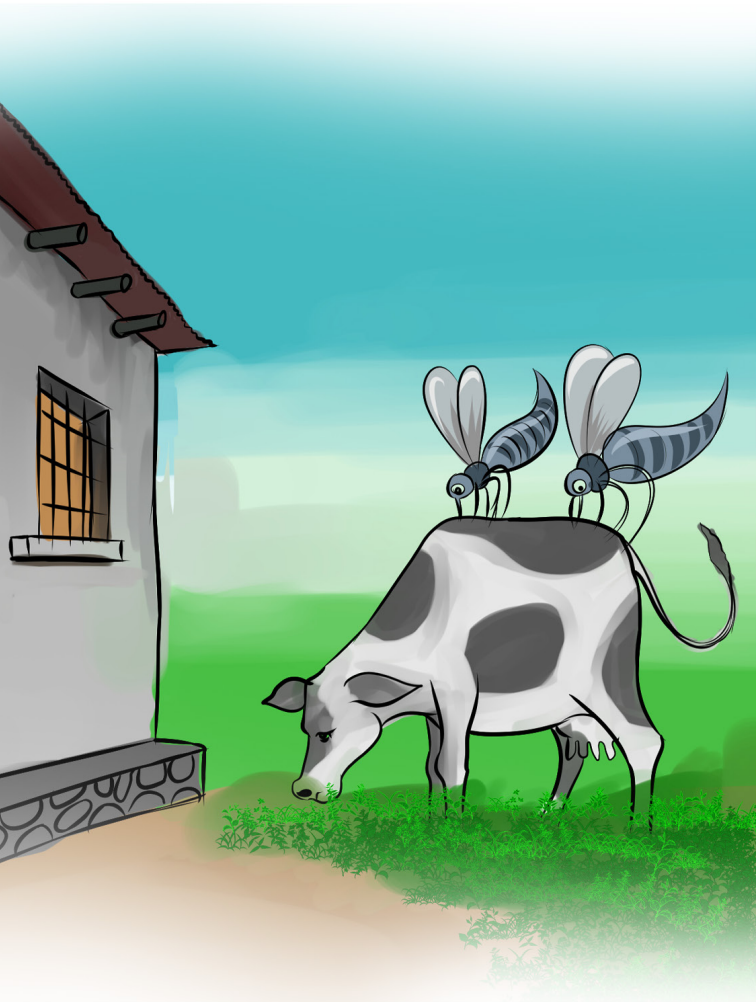
Soon, Mr. Mosquito started his routine of biting three people a day and sucking blood from cows. His friends did likewise and there was restlessness because of mosquitoes.



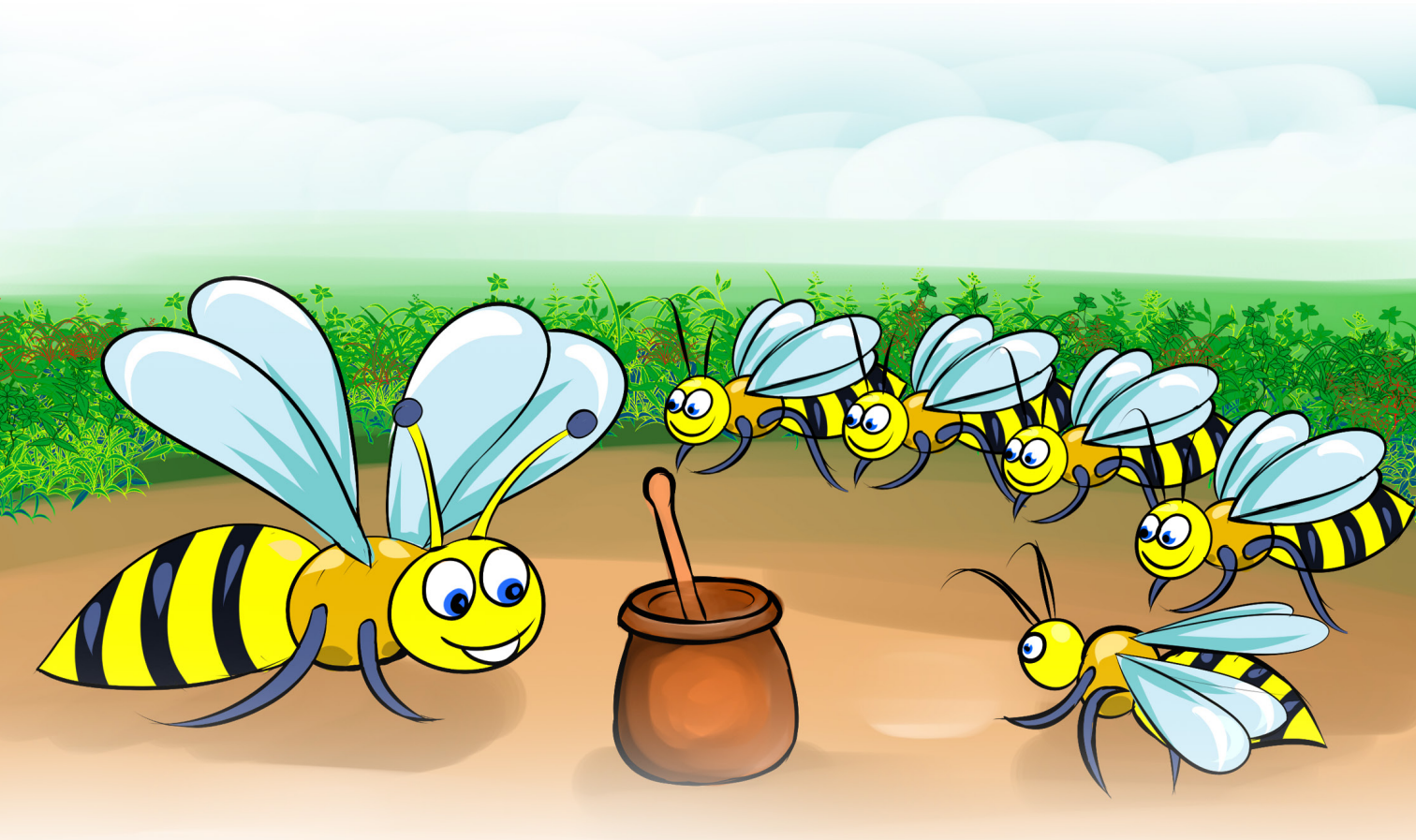

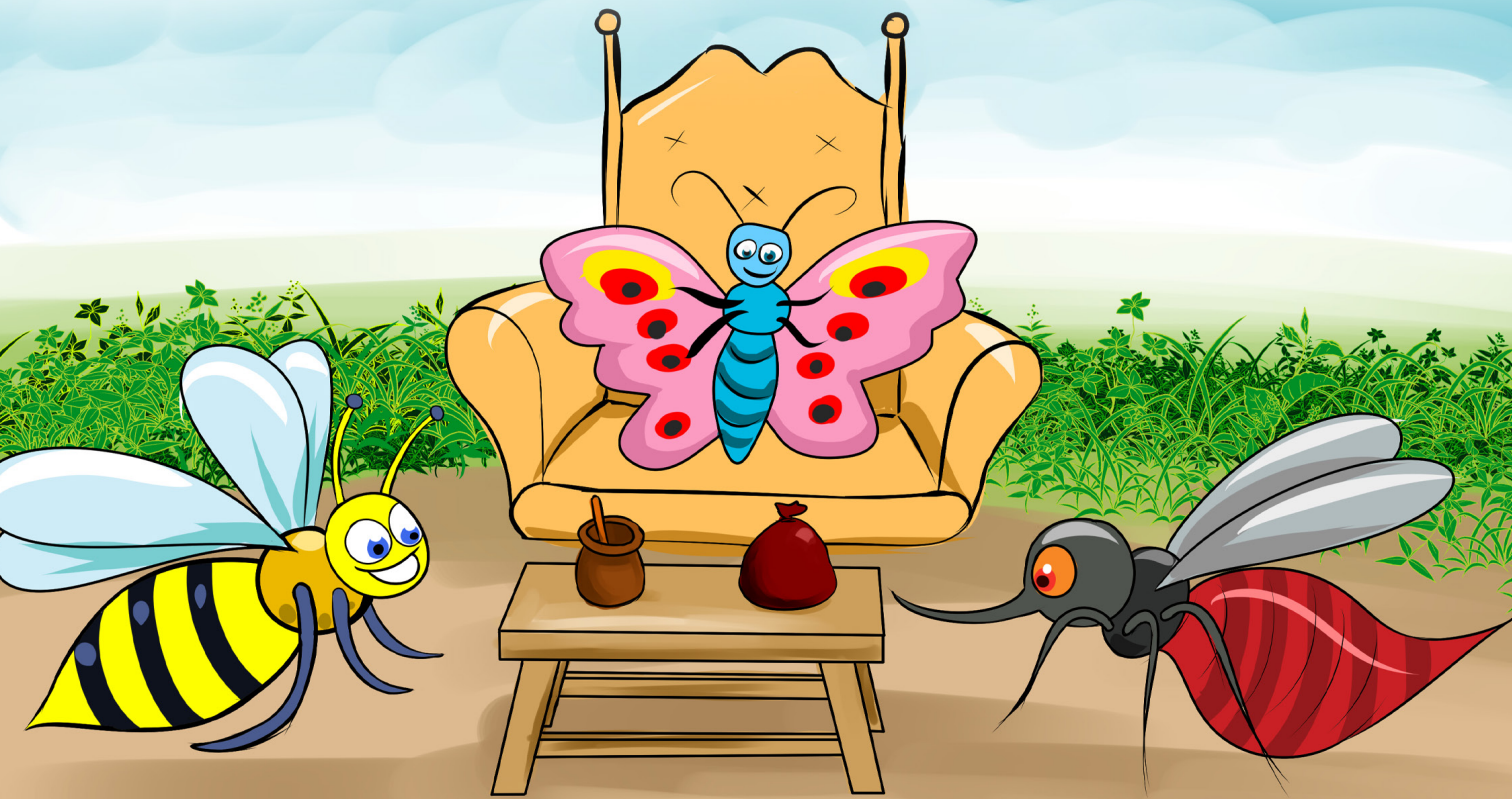

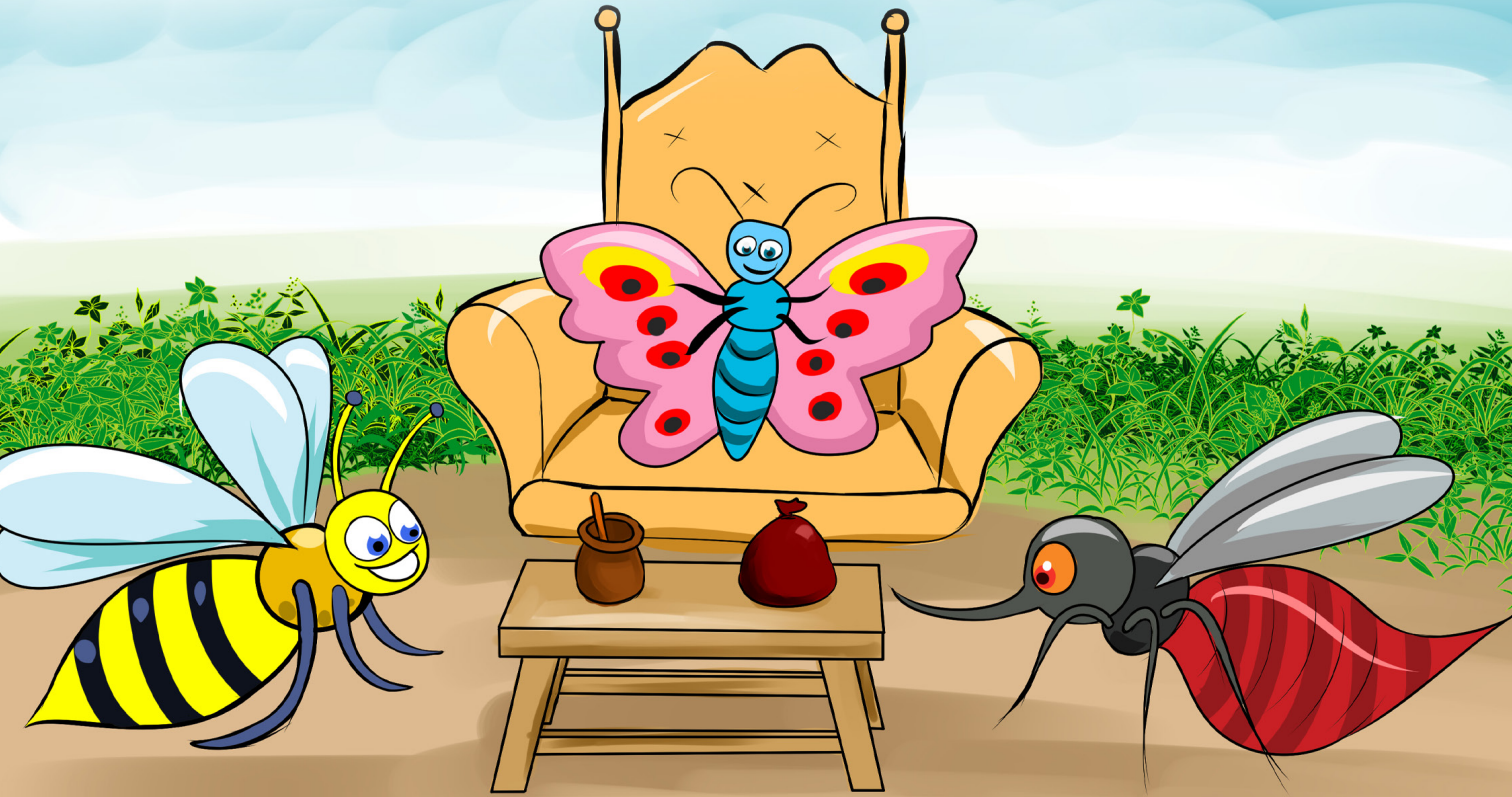
