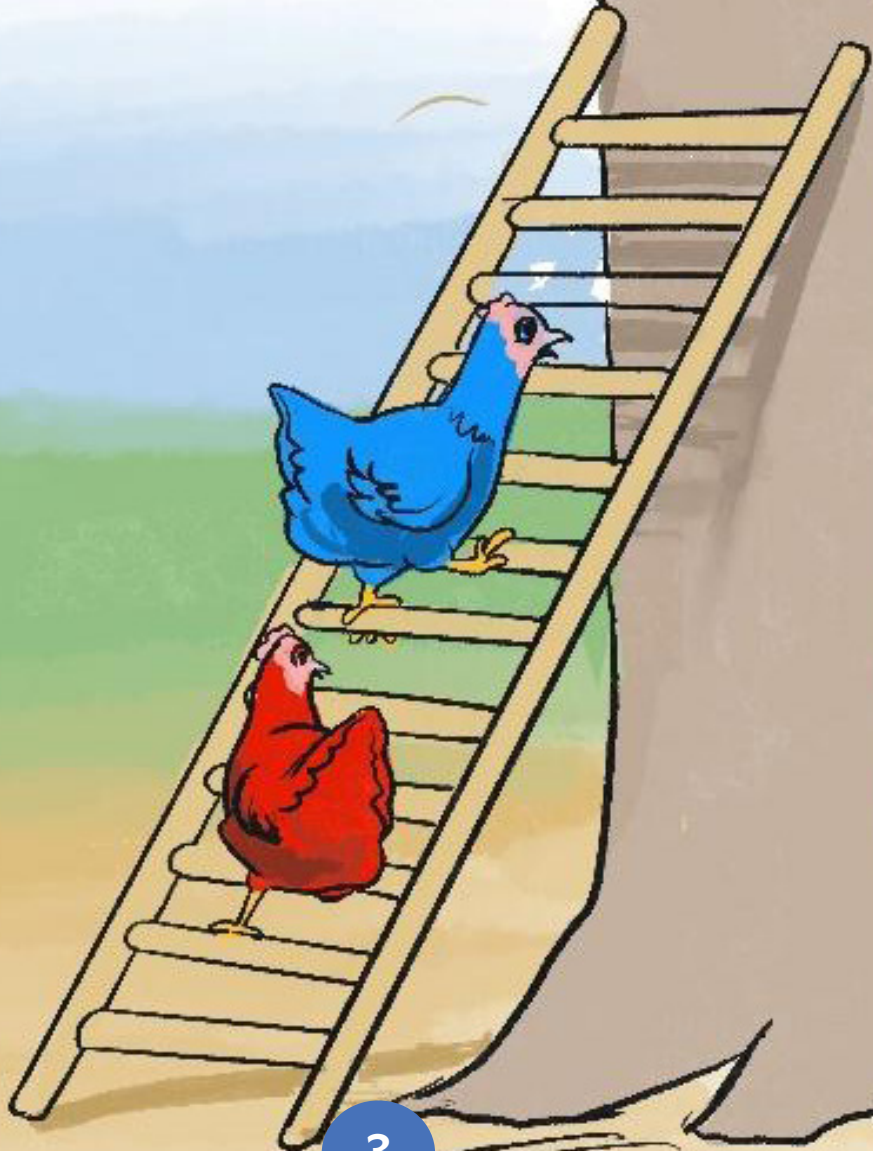

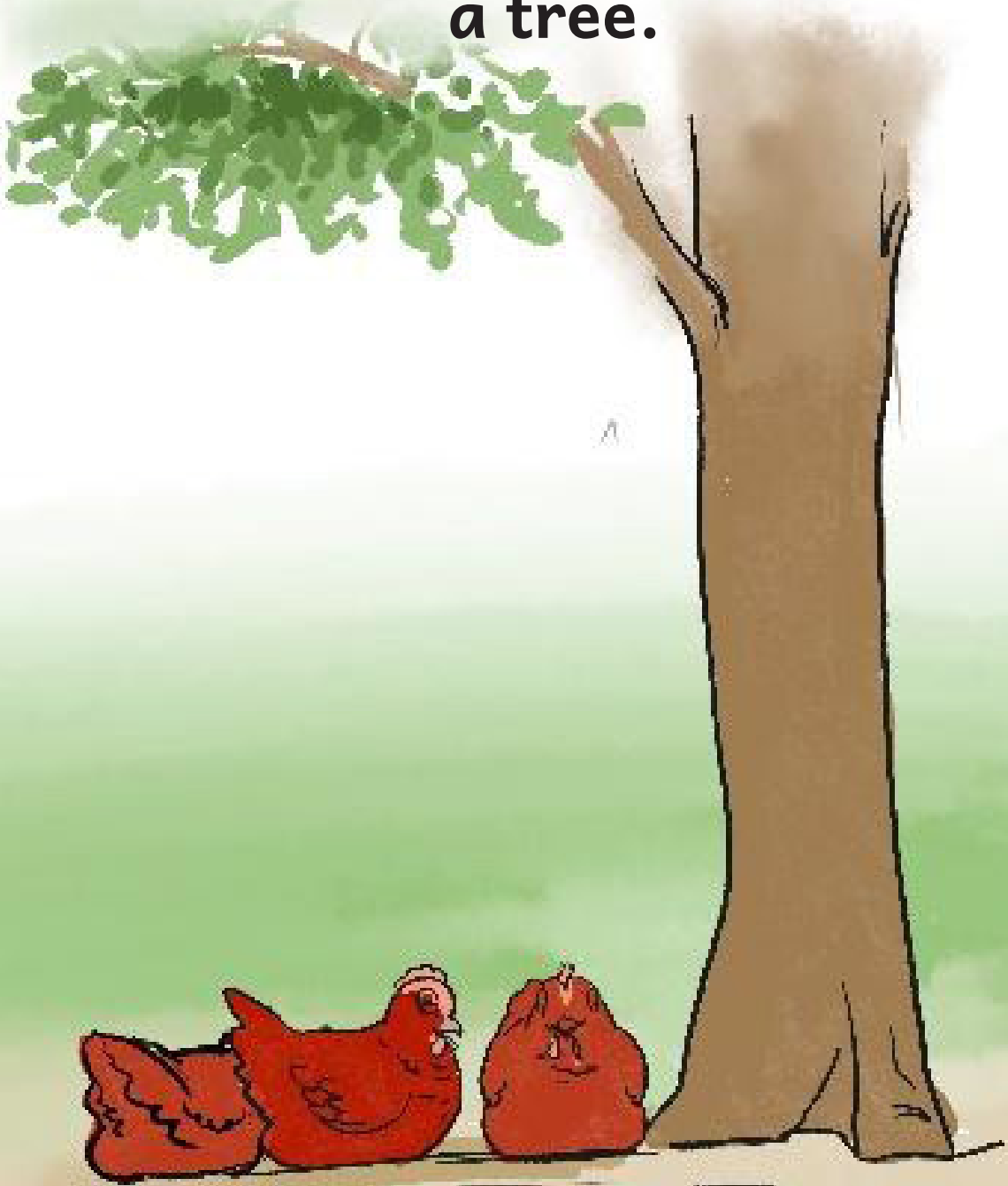
Two hens go up.

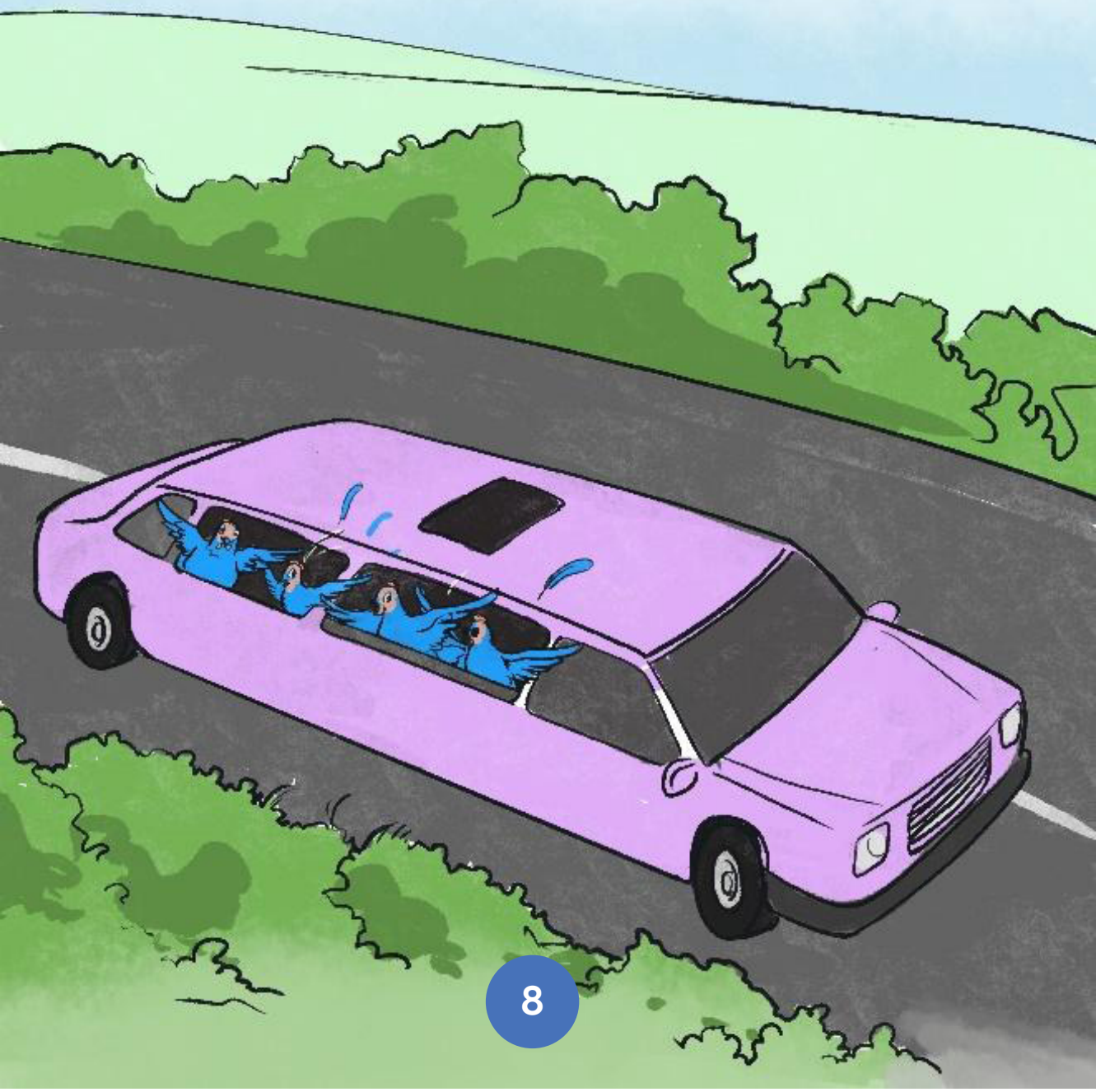




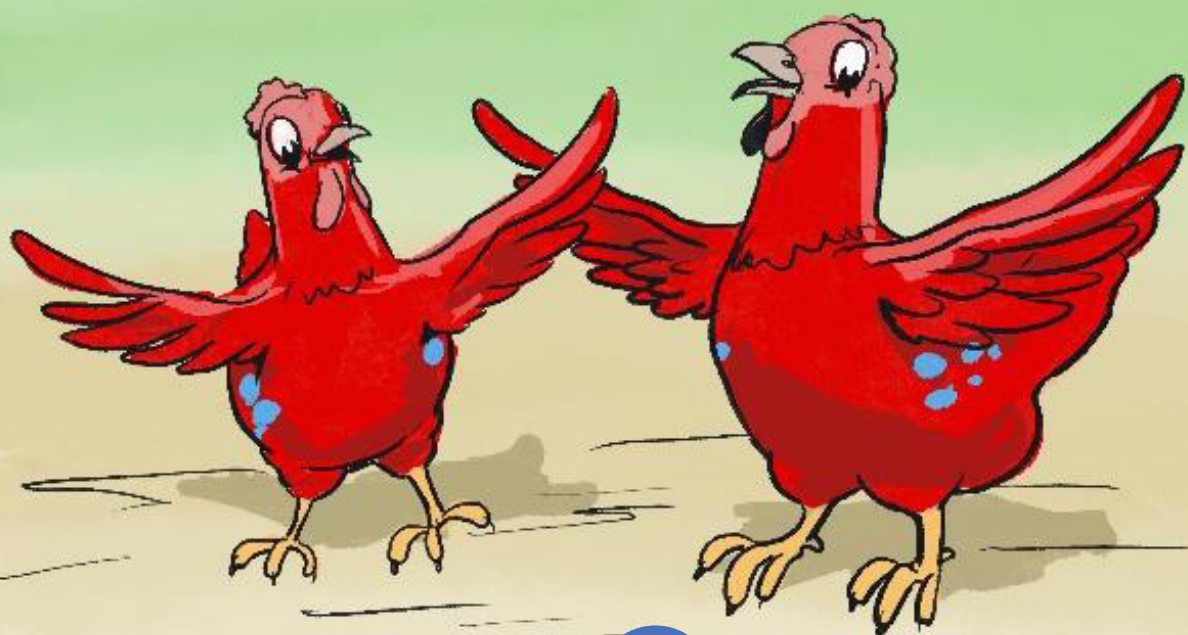
A red hen in a  
small car.



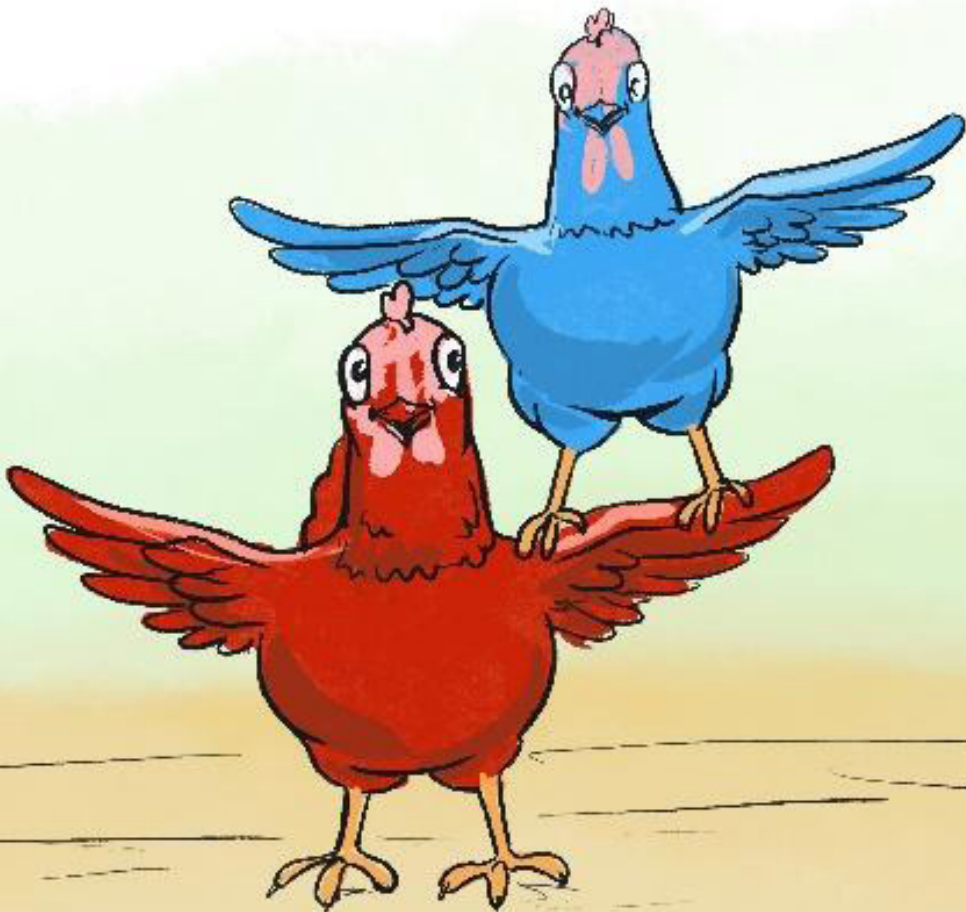
Four blue hens

with blue spots.**

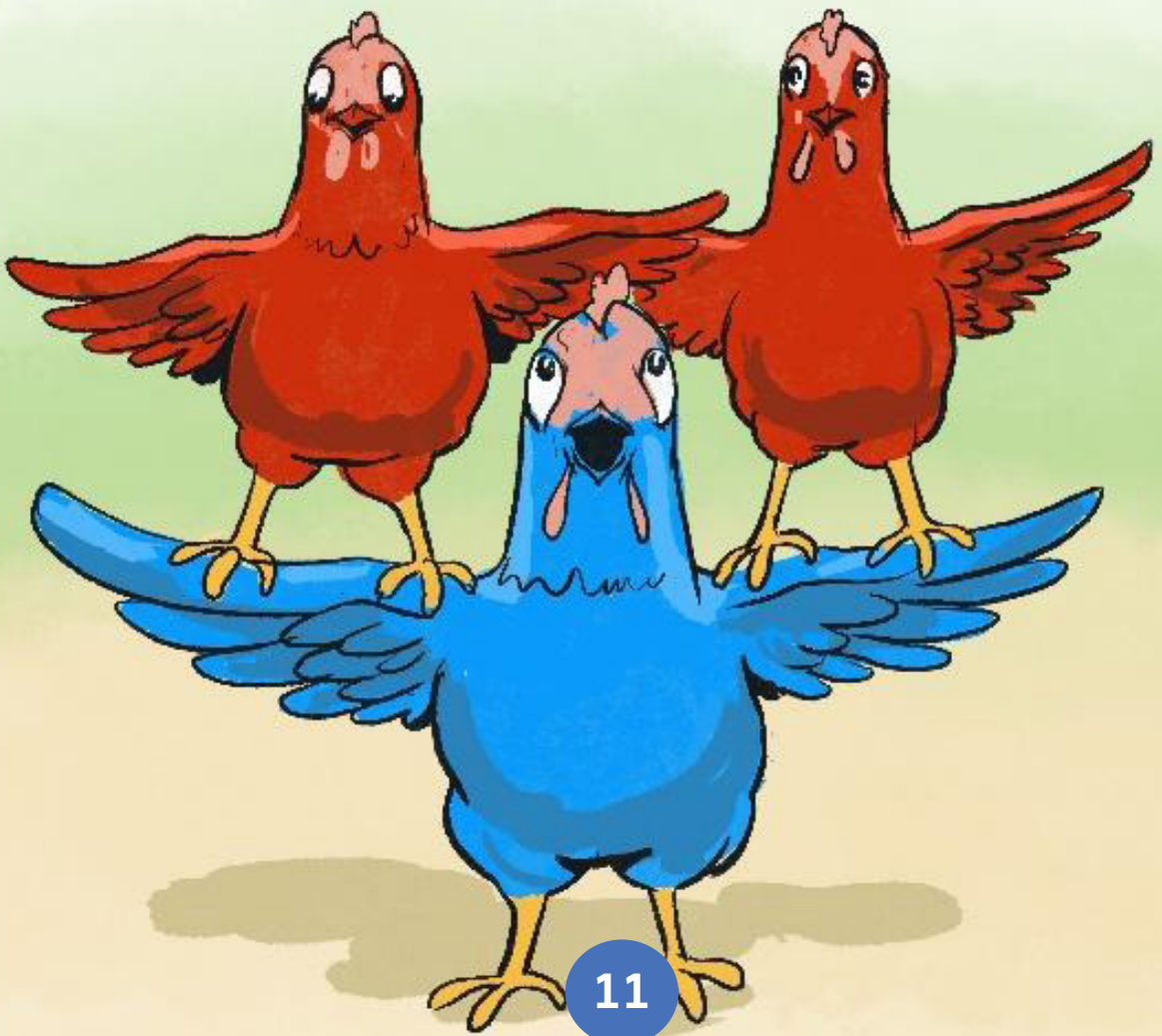


A blue hen on  
a red hen.



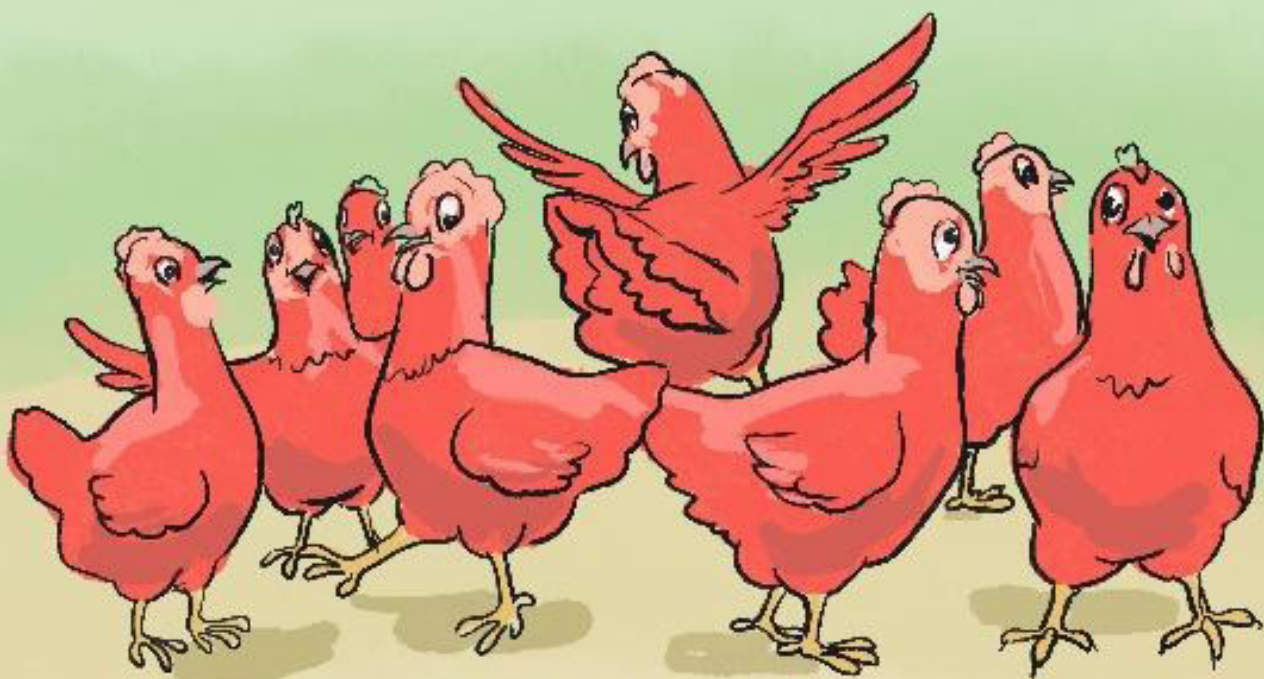


Two red hens on  
a blue hen.

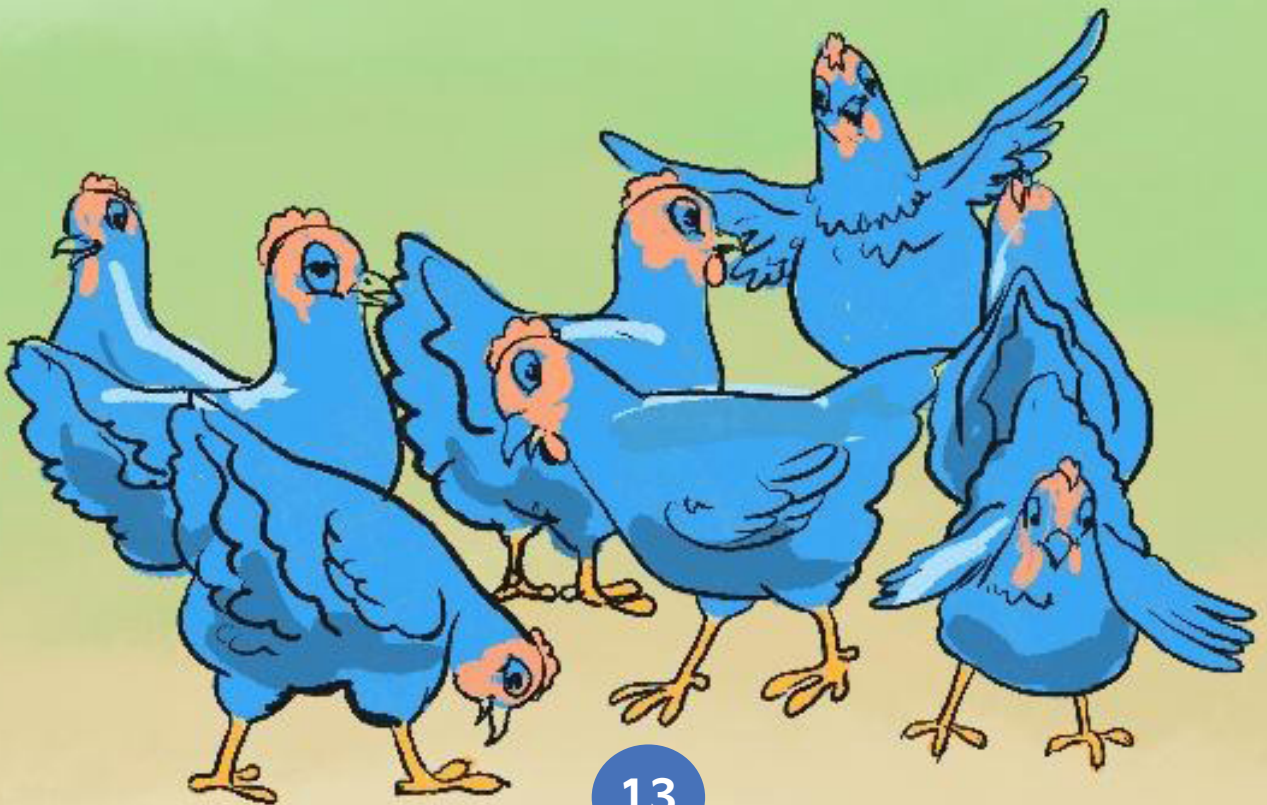




**A lot of red hens!**
