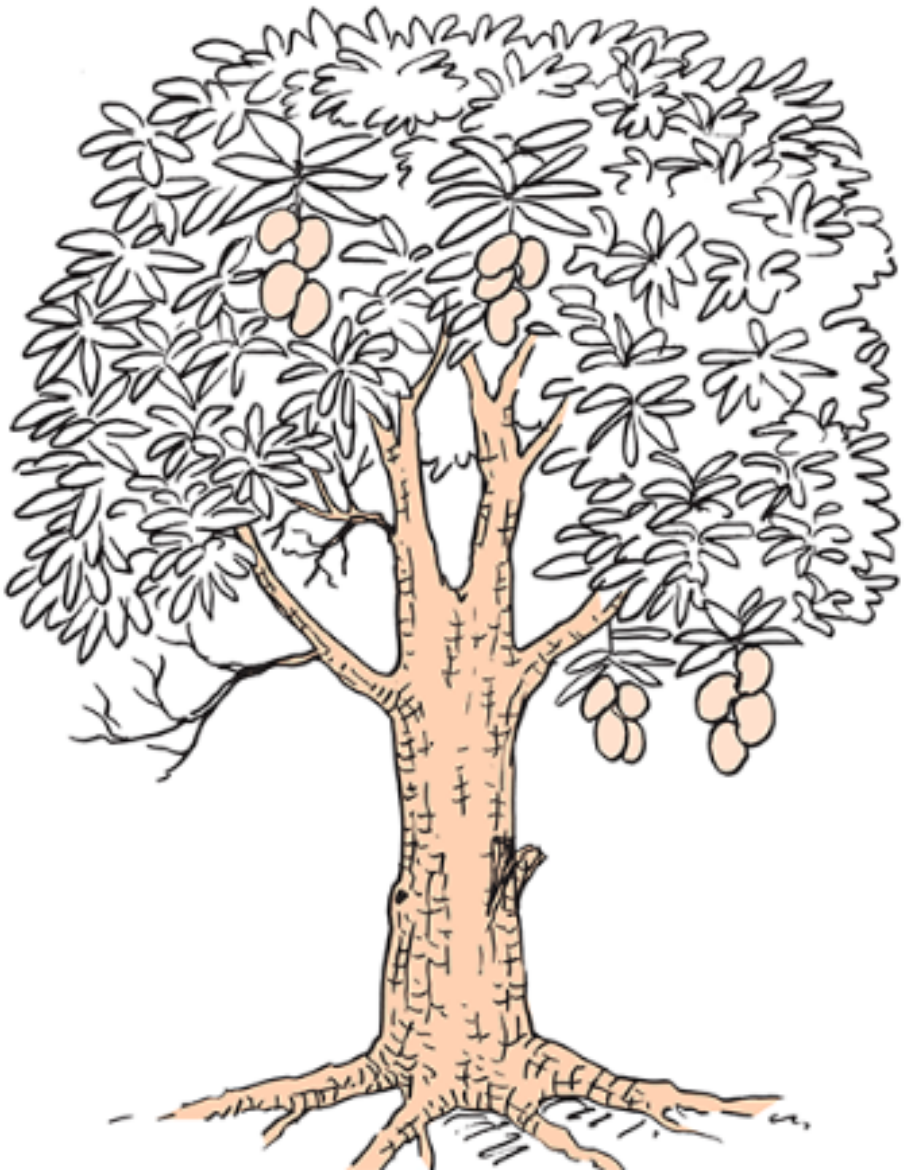

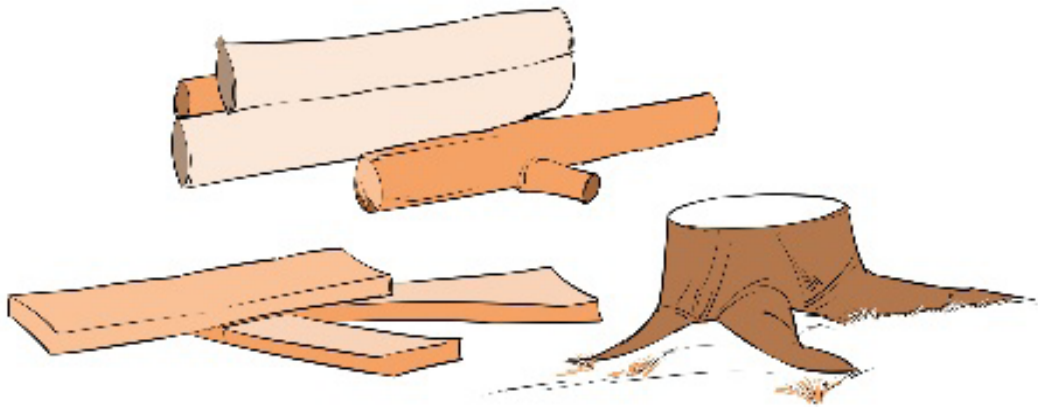
We use the trunk of

Trees give us clean air.



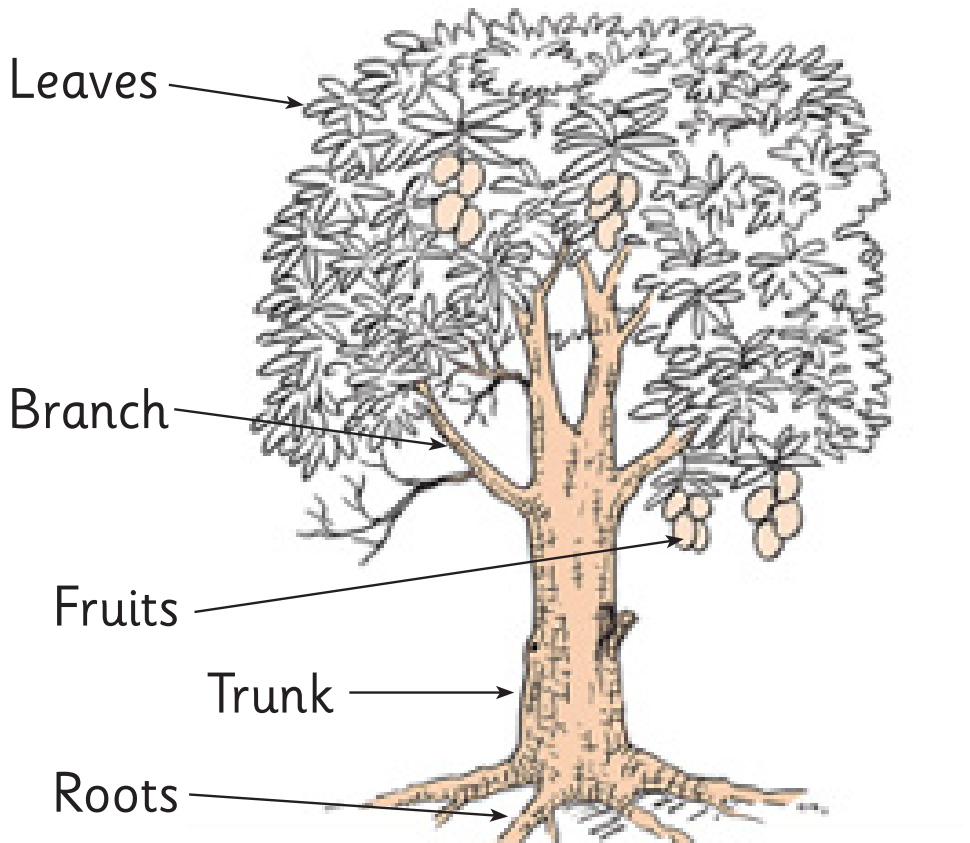
