Video conference overview

Aims

In this video conference dialogue with your global peers, you will have the opportunity to share and learn about peace and security in different contexts and communities while practicing key dialogue skills:

- Sharing - speak for yourself only and not on behalf of others; use 'I' and not 'we'.
- Responding - stay curious; ask critical questions; seek clarification for what you do not understand; show you value the contributions of others
- Reflecting - keep asking yourself what you are learning, how you are learning and what this new learning means for you.

Dialogue should evolve, so we don't want you to come to this dialogue with scripted questions or speeches, but you might want to think about these things prior to the video conference:

1. What does peace mean to you?
2. What does peace and security look like in your community? Share examples.
3. What actions have been taken to provide peace and security in your community?
4. In which ways do you consider that peace and security in other countries impacts us all?

Tip

- Being nervous is normal. The best way to overcome your nerves is to join in. Be brave!
- Make sure you are in a space where you will not be disturbed or distracted by others (or devices) before the conference!

Discuss these questions with your students before the dialogue to prepare them in addition to the skill building activities
